(1x) Rifle, (1x) Shotgun and (2x) Handgun Centre fire only! - Now 6 Stages Shooting starts at 0930 hrs. Range Safety Brief 0900 hrs. THIS IS AN INFORMAL FUN MATCH! JOIN US.

Course of Fire:

Stage 1 Rifle.

Approx. 10 Steel plates, various sizes, to be taken out with any rifle (your choice of sights). Plates must be knocked over to score. We are using the plate rack. Scoring for stage 1 will be determined by overall time taken to knock down all 10 plates. Max 10 min

Stage II Long Range Handgun.

Approx. 10 pepper poppers or equivalent steel to be engaged with your handgun, maximum range, a long long way! Scoring: Same as stage 1. Max 10 min

Stage III Rifle Grouping.

Open to your center fire rifle. Five rds grouping on to paper target at approx 100 to 300 yds, freestyle. No sighting shots. Smallest group on the paper wins. Max 5 min. Scoring will be determined as such: 10 points (seconds per mm) Example - 50mm group: 500 points

Stage IV Long Range Shotgun.

Approx. 10 pepper poppers or equivalent to be engaged with your shotgun (Slugs). Scoring as per stage 1. Max 10 min

Stage V Handgun and Back Up handgun. No rim fire

5 Red Fab Defense targets to engage with your primary Handgun, three rounds in each target. Secondary handgun will engage 5 Yellow Fab Defense Targets again three rounds in each target. No limit on number of shots fired, repeated twice. Scoring: 20 seconds penalty for each miss, Fastest total time wins. Max 10 min. **PLEASE NOTE: Your back up handgun can be any size and caliber providing she is smaller than your primary handgun.**

Stage VI The Saw Mill.

One standard 2x4 must be sawed in half by using 10rds of your rifle. Followed by 10rds from your primary handgun, and finishing with as much from your shotgun slugs until the board is in two pieces (broken to 90 degrees). Approx. 20 meter range Max 10 min

Extra Info

Match winner is aggregate of stage positions. In the event of a tie the score in stage III will used. (Rifle group size)

Range Safety: Please note on our range all firearms must be cased, slung or holstered. There will be no handling of firearms on the firing point when people are forward. **Holsters, we encourage competitors to use good quality holsters.** No shoulder holsters that carry the gun with the barrel in a horizontal position will be allowed. Once your R.O. gives you the load and make ready, you will load your required firearms. In stages where more than one firearm is required the second piece when loaded will be placed on the station in front of you, there will be no moving with the loaded gun, and there will be no requirement to holster a loaded handgun. **Start Position, free style but loaded gun, will have muzzle down range. No competitor will leave the firing point until all their guns have been cleared by the Range Officer [RO]**

Warning: Anyone who breaks 90 with a loaded firearm earns an immediate match disqualification.

Hot Food will be available at the midpoint of the day.

Come out and have fun with us. This is an informal shoot. Trophies for top three places. Entry fee is \$20.00 for Club members and \$25 for non-members.
